

## NoSpooF Option for XMITIP

In its delivered form, XMITIP has the option of either displaying an antispoofing message or leaving it off. Because of the ease of spoofing (faking) the userid of the person who sent you an email, the antispoofing message was created so that you will be able to see who really sent you the email message you received. The antispoofing message displays, at the bottom of the email, the job name, Userid, the User Name, System Id and the date/time (see example):

This option is set at installation time and, once set, can't be changed on an email-to-email basis. It is either set to place the antispoofing message in all emails or no message in all emails. There may be some cases where it is not, either for security or aesthetic reasons, desirable to display this message (especially when sending emails to students).

The NoSpooF option is a local customization that allows you the option of removing the antispoofing message (our default is to have the antispoofing message displayed). To invoke this option, place it as shown in the example below:
